YAD advertised for the submission of Expression of Interest for theater performances regarding access to maternal health, safe abortion and post abortion care. The requirements were advertised on social media and local news paper to proceed for further implementations. After the procurement process completed at first YAD conducted 4 Theater Performances in different locations and venues and planned to conduct the last theater and cultural performance in the Mega Event to achieve it's objectives at the maximum.

YAD successfully conducted its fifth cultural and theatre performance through a group known as Fancy Club. The theatre was kept for the Mega Event to create awareness among general public to reduce barriers to maternal health services. YAD organized a cultural theatre performance in the Mega Event with script, slogans & messages of access to safe abortion and barriers to maternal health services. The theatre was performed with a heart wrenching story of a young girl who was not matured enough to get married but had to give up on her dreams for her family. Later it was also shown that how the young girl faced issues during her maternity period and how she miscarries her child due to inadequate attention and care by her in-laws. It was also represented that a child cannot bear the pain to deliver a child as her body cannot bear this stress and pain. The story and script created an environment full of awareness for public.

YAD representatives have made great efforts for the Creative artistic activism engaging fine arts departments. The activity required continuous coordination with the fine arts departments students, arts galleries & artists for organizing painting competition & exhibition. The process started with the advertisement for the submission of Expression of Interest from artists, ameteur artists, youth and other interested candidates for painting and art work submission and compitition, regarding access to maternal health, safe abortion and post abortion care. The requirements were advertised on social media and local news paper to proceed for further implementations. Submission process of artworks and paintings by interested candidates was completed a day before Mega Event (All Arts Painting Competition and Exhibition) on 26th September, 2020. Meanwhile, YAD Representatives conducted several meetings with artists and visited art gallariers to create awareness about the painting compitition and exhibition. YAD Representatives visited "Directorate of Culture and Arts Department Quetta" to request for the technical assistance in the "Mega Event" which was decided to be conducted on 27th September, 2020 at Noori Naseer Complex "Directorate of Culture & Arts" gallery. The proper publicity of the said event was done directly and through social media to make maximum participation possible. We also visited several arts academies to aware general people about the "All Arts Competition" and received positive response from variou







On Mega Event Day 27th September, 2020, YAD successfully engaged fine arts departments, students, artists and fine art acadamies to participate for "All Arts Competition and Exhibition". YAD received around 150 Paintings from the artists all over Balochistan to conduct the painting competition and exhibition under the theme "Barriers to maternal health services and safe abortion". This exhibition and competition was conducted as a main part of the Mega Event. Several artists submitted their creative work to raise the issues through creativity. Also the winners were decided by the jury members without personal interests. Each winner was given a cash prize according to his/her position.

• For the First position 2 winners were announced and given cash prize of 35000/- PKR to each first position holder.

• For the Second position 2 winners were announced and given cash prize of 25000/- PKR to each second position holder.

• For the Third position 2 winners were announced and given cash prize of 20000/- PKR to each third position holder.

3.6 Conductin g Two safe abortion storytellin g	YAD has successfully conducted 2 safe abortion and maternal health issues story telling meetings with two different communities. The purpose of these meetings were to discuss and know the issues faced by women at grass root level. Also females were encouraged to stop bearing maternal health issues and raise their voice for women empowerment to establish a society where no women remains unattended by qualified health workers, gynaecologists. Women from different backgrounds attended these story telling meetings and shared their problems and health issues during and after maternity.

The documentary included the interview of the hired consultant, powerful women stories regarding the maternal health issues they faced, communities clips and experienced lady health worker interview. The documentary screening has been conducted according to the plan in the Mega Event where in the huge auditorium the general public, stake holders, social and political influencers and government officials attended the Documentary Screening Ceremony. The developed documentary was screened to meet the project objective "Raising awareness to augment active participation of mothers, women, girls, youth, caregivers, caretakers and gatekeepers in decision-making processes for the realization of safe abortion, curbing abortion barriers, stigma and decriminalization of abortion in Baluchistan". The documentary included stories and interviews of women who are/were facing issues related to maternity, unsafe abortion and barriers to maternal health. Also the documentary includes an interview by a Lady Health Worker who highlighted several cases and deaths occurred due to the unsafe abortions and severe maternal health problems in the region. Also it included an interview by Mr Ashraf (consultant) on the behalf of YAD to raise how YAD has been working for the project "Collective learning & action to understand & reduce barriers to maternal health services and mainstreaming these at policies and community level in Quetta Balochistan" funded by AmplifyChange. The documentary is entitled as "Every Mother Counts, Let's Save Them" which not only caught the attention but also spread a positive message to the audience.

Challenge	Solutions/ mitigation
Purchasing Equipment	Covid-19 pandemic caused complete lockdown situation in the province, challenges were faced in purchasing equipment as a need for organizational strengthening. Right after relaxation by Provincial Government in lockdown following the SOPs, equipment were purchased without any delay.
Conducting Visits and Meetings	Due to Covid-19 pandemic we faced some difficulties in meeting with stakeholders. Visits were done by creating linkages by using diversified strategies. We visited art galleries, universities fine arts departments and mass communication departments. Also we visited media & mass communication representatives to bring ideas for documentary development plan. We have started creating networks and linkages with stakeholders, target groups involving minorities as well.
Taking Consents for Conducting Key Informant Interviews	Abortion has remained a stigmatized matter in Pakistan. Therefore, our team has managed and utilized best tactics, strategies to conduct fair interviews from the key informants to bring out the real and grass-root level information of ground realities from communities and individuals. Each interview was conducted after providing information about the purpose and objectives of the project.
Gathering groups for Focused Group Discussions	During the pandemic it was a challenge for the team to gather people on the specific time to conduct focused group discussions. The SOPs were followed to maintain social distancing. The activity was monitored by YAD's Monitoring & Evaluation officer to achieve the objectives without violating SOPs.
Venue unavailability	Due to Covid-19 we faced difficulties to find an appropriate venue to conduct our upcoming Mega Event. The place which was planned was Boys Scoutts Association but was changed to Directorate of Cultural and Arts Department.

Selecting women having powerful stories and experiences of maternal health issues	YAD selected the most relevant story tellers for making the documentary. YAD Project Staff met with several story tellers among which the most relevant women are identified.
Arrangements for Mega Event	For the Mega Event YAD Representatives visited to several Government and Private Offices for collaboration, coordination, invitation and security request. YAD Representatives requested Local Government for the security persons, walk through gate and other essentials.
Venue for Conducting Consultative follow-up and lobbying meetings	Due to Covid-19 the venues were difficult to arrange therefore we split 2 of our lobbying meetings into 4. The strategy was applied because of congested space and to make sure that maximum participants can attend the meetings.
Successfully Conducting the Mega Event	The whole Mega Event was itself a challenge for YAD Team. The Mega Event was conducted after repeated coordination meetings for a successful implementation of planning. To do so, several committees were formed by YAD Management which included its volunteers, counsellor facilitators assigned with different responsibilities. Through proper responsibility sharing, rehearsals and coordination we were able to conduct mega event in which more than 1100 people visited throughout the day.

	The importance of adopting the methodology of networking, volunteers committee formation plays a huge role in the achievement of stakeholder engagement process, maximum number of people involvement and participation.

One of the objective which we learnt and on the way to achieve is "Collective learning & action to understand & reduce barriers to maternal health services and mainstreaming these at policies and community level." We have made a great experience of collective learning and understanding about the actions to achieve the goal of the project. The actions which we have learned to understand & reduce barriers to safe abortion and maternal health, during the reporting period and will be adopted in upcoming reporting period are: Documentary Making. Film Festival Networking with the identified stakeholders not limited to, youth groups, artists, musicians, cultural representatives, film and documentary makers, bloggers, writers, journalists. Has the lesson made any difference to the outcomes of the project?	The lesson has made the implementation of the plan quite productive. It has made the outcomes more efficient and effective for general public.

Yes, definitely the methodology of engaging stakeholders through networking for raising awareness will be continued in the upcoming quarter as we are expecting for "Cultural and Musical Night" to be conducted for the same purpose. And we are planning to adopt more innovative ideas for maximum coverage by journalists, news channels, media etc for raising the matter.
What do we aim to achieve with this specific lesson?	We aim to reduce barriers to safe abortion and post abortion care, maternal health, and conduct our activities in an innovative way. Also we want to engage maximum stakeholders and beneficiaries for optimal achievement.
