





Total Number of Finalists in Folk Games Tournaments:

155 Players

YAD has successfully conducted folk games with male and female communities with the messages, awareness and slogans of safe abortion and post-abortion care. Women were encouraged to raise their voice among communities and public to achieve the objectives of the project. The folk games were played in a traditional manner in context of local customs and norms. Also the purpose of the project and completed activities were also highlighted to make people aware of the need of raising awareness and promote active participation.

Outputs Created:

- Women and Men were involved separately in the folk games
- Messages and awareness was created through folk games to promote the objective of the project.
- Discussions were made with the communities for the realization of safe abortion, curbing abortion barriers, stigma and decriminalization of safe abortion and access to maternal health services in Balochistan.

Organizing 05 local cultural theatre performances in communities, schools, colleges, academics & universities with script, slogans & messages of access to safe abortion

Total Number of Audience:

1395

YAD advertised for the submission of Expression of Interest for theater performances regarding access to maternal health, safe abortion and post abortion care. The requirements were advertised on social media and local news paper to proceed for further implementations. After the procurement process completed at first YAD conducted 4 Theater Performances in different locations and venues and planned to conduct the last theater and cultural performance in the Mega Event to achieve it's objectives at the maximum.

YAD successfully conducted its fifth cultural and theatre performance through a group known as Fancy Club. The theatre was kept for the Mega Event to create awareness among general public to reduce barriers to maternal health services. YAD organized a cultural theatre performance in the Mega Event with script, slogans & messages of access to safe abortion and barriers to maternal health services. The theatre was performed with a heart wrenching story of a young girl who was not matured enough to get married but had to give up on her dreams for her family. Later it was also shown that how the young girl faced issues during her maternity period and how she miscarries her child due to inadequate attention and care by her in-laws. Submission process of artworks and paintings by interested candidates was completed a day before Mega Event (All Arts Painting Competition and Exhibition) on 26th September, 2020. Meanwhile, YAD Representatives conducted several meetings with artists and visited art galleries to create awareness about the painting competition and exhibition. YAD Representatives visited "Directorate of Culture and Arts Department Quetta" to request for the technical assistance in the "Mega Event" which was decided to be conducted on 27th September, 2020 at Noori Naseer Complex "Directorate of Culture & Arts" gallery. The proper publicity of the said event was done directly and through social media to make maximum participation possible. We also visited several arts academies to aware general people about the "All Arts Competition" and received positive response from various



On Mega Event Day 27th September, 2020, YAD successfully engaged fine arts departments, students, artists and fine art academies to participate for "All Arts Competition and Exhibition". YAD received around 150 Paintings from the artists all over Balochistan to conduct the painting competition and exhibition under the theme "Barriers to maternal health services and safe abortion". We were told to generate a request online and YAD processed the request for Toll free helpline. We remained in contact with the concern authority Pakistan Tele Communication imited (PTCL) and the PTCL persons visited the site and checked the distribution point (DP). Cutting the long story, the PTCL company excused for it and we have received regret email from PTCL and its attached in report. YAD office has only one land line number and Toll Free Helpline require two more land line numbers. 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| Lesson Learned | <p>During the implementation of the major activity "Raising awareness to augment active participation of mothers, women, girls, youth, caregivers, caretakers and gatekeepers in decision-making processes for the realization of safe abortion, curbing abortion barriers, stigma and decriminalization of abortion in Baluchistan" we learned that it is more productive and effective to engage stakeholders through edutainment and activities like Documentary making, songs containing messages regarding the objectives of the project, folk games, theatre performances and other sub-activities which can create and raise awareness through creativity, edutainment, film making, cultural and musical shows and are more effective than traditional methods such as meetings, trainings etc. Because through the mentioned activities and Mega Events, general public can be attracted more towards the real message of the project which YAD delivers.</p> <p>The importance of adopting the methodology of networking, volunteers committee formation plays a huge role in the achievement of stakeholder engagement process, maximum number of people involvement and participation.</p> <p>The process includes the following steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
